Bonnaroo Checklist

- 1 Sleeping Bag/Pillow
- Clothes (casual + 4 days work clothes, black or khaki pants only, extra socks.)
- Toiletries
- Towels
- Shower Shoes (ie: sandals)
- Insect Repellant
- Sun Protection (ie: Sunscreen, hat)
- Rain Gear (ie: Poncho, Rubber Boots – it could rain...)
- Jacket – It gets a bit COLD at night!
- Flashlight
- Leatherman multi-tool
- Pocket size snacks for between meals and between shifts
- Movies – both VHS and DVDs (for the bus ride. No vulgarity please!)

**Hair dryers will not be allowed due to electrical issues in the tents!*

**You may bring a small” personal-sized” tent to pitch within the large carnival sized air-conditioned tent housing all W3 personnel for your own ability to provide a private sanctuary.*

**You will be responsible for securing all of your belongings at all times while onsite.*

Pack Light!

You are only allowed 1 bag/suitcase and 1 sleeping bag. While shopping for toiletries, think travel size and buy just enough to last the week.

- All meals provided and paid for (during travel and onsite)

- Air conditioned tents, cots, and shower facilities provided onsite
